## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68368** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **James W. Mason, Jr. of Box 8, Lawen, Oregon 97740, phone 493-2815,** for the use of the waters of an unnamed slough, a tributary of Malheur Lake,  
for the PURPOSE of **supplemental irrigation of 53.5 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 5, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.67 cubic feet per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **990 feet South and 1220 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 30, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 24 South, Range 32 1/2 East, WM, being within the County of Harney.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 24 South, Range 32 1/2 East, WM Section 31 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 18.7 acres  
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.8 acres  
Section 32 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 13.3 acres  
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 18.7 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided futher that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, the right may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water supply appropriated under Application G-11378, Permit G-10512, provided that the total quantity diverted from both sources of supply shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **August 9, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
