## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68369 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Donald M. Burch of 3110 SE Clay Street, Albany, Oregon 97321, phone 928-8230, for the use of the waters of Staats Creek, a tributary of Berry Creek,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 3.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

June 5, 1985

16.8 gallons per and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 840 feet South and 2040 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 4, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 10 South, Range 5 West, WM, being within the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 10 South, Range 5 West, WM

Section 4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.0 acres

The AMDUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

August 9, 1986 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
