PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68431 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Joe T. Poplin and B.M. Poplin of PO Box 41, Glendale, Oregon 97442, for the use of the waters of Windy Creek, a tributary of Cow Creek,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 0.5 acre

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

July 9, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1080 feet South and 120 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 33, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 33, Township 32 South, Range 6 West, W4, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 33 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.5 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to the irrigation of a non-commercial garden during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 30, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
