PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68433 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following 68433 limitations and conditions:

Alvin G. Frias of 291 Acorn Drive, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 673-4999, for the use of the waters of North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River,

the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 1.8 acres, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.023 cfs for irrigation for the PURPOSE of

July 10, 1985 that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

0.028 cubic foot and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1760 feet South and 850 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 13, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 18 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.4 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.4 acres & dom

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/30 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

August 30, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with Actual construction work shall begin on or before reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
