PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 58433 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Gerald Tomlinson of Route 2, Box 884, Astoria, Oregon 97103, phone 458-6247, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Ferris Creek,

for the PURPOSE of livestock and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for livestock and 0.01 cfs for domestic use that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 16, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second 0.015 cubic foot

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 350 feet North and 300 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 25, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM Section 25 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Livestock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 30, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
