## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68001** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Diamond Lake Improvement Co., for the United States, Umpqua National Forest of Diamond Lake, Oregon 97731, phone 793-3333, for the use of the waters of a spring area, a tributary of an unnamed tributary stream to Lake Creek, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for 10 housing units at work center and maintenance of fire protection system at work center and Diamond Lake Lodge, being 0.01 cfs for domestic use and 0.01 cfs for maintenance of fire protection systems.** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **February 28, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.02 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **2420 feet North and 2950 feet East from the Northwest Corner of the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 27 South, Range 6 East, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 25, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87** Extended to October 1, 1991, **10-1-92**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88** Extended to October 1, 1991, **10-1-92**
