This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68380 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Kent W. and Edith May Ferris of 716 North Bay Drive, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-6418, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Haynes Inlet,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

June 10, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 395 feet North and 215 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 24 South, Range 13 West, WM Section 35 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 25, 1936nd shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
