PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68383** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of PO Box 3503, Portland, Oregon 97208, phone 229-5674,** for the use of the waters of the Clackamas River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of **fish culture**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 3, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **5.0 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1100 feet South and 2100 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 4 East, WM Section 19 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Fish Culture

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 25, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
