PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68480** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Douglas Fanning of Route 1, Box 38, Amity, Oregon 97101, phone 835-3400**, for the use of the waters of an unnamed reservoir, a tributary of South Yamhill River, to be constructed under Application R-68479, Permit R-10513, for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 13.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **August 13, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **3.3 acre-feet of stored water only**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **540 feet North and 550 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 1, Township 6 South, Range 5 West, WM, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 36, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 South, Range 5 West, WM	Section 36 SE 1/4 SW 1/4	1.1 acres
Township 6 South, Range 5 West, WM	Section 1 NW 1/4 NW 1/4	3.7 acres
	NE 1/4 NW 1/4	3.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to **2.5 acre-feet per acre per year for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10513.**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **September 25, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
