PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68534 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David W. Horner of Route 1, Box 328, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, phone 357-3259, for the use of the waters of two drainage ditches and 24.0 acre-feet stored water from an excavated sump reservoir to be constructed under * for the PURPOSE of recreation and supplemental irrigation of 54.8 acres, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from south drainage ditch with any deficiency in the available supply from the south drainage ditch to be made up by appropriation from** that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 29, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 1200 feet South and 710 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9; Diversion 2 - 1150 feet South and 920 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9; Diversion 3 - 1800 feet South and 880 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, being within the *** A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Application R-68473, Permit R-10529, a tributary of Dairy Creek,
- ** the north drainage ditch for maintaining 1.0 acre-foot of stored water in the sump reservoir for recreation and 24.0 acre-feet of stored water from the sump reservoir for supplemental irrigation
- *** SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, all within Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM Section 9 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.8 acres

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 25.9 acres Recreation NE 1/4 SW 1/4 23.5 acres Recreation NW 1/4 SE 1/4 4.6 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed of one cubic foot per second per acre, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.
