PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60189 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Fremont National Forest of PO Box 551, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-2151, for the use of the waters of Paradise Creek, a tributary of South Fork Sprague River, for the PURPOSE of road watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 26, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South 84 degrees East 1056 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 35, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 1, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88 .
