PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **60190** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States, Fremont National Forest of PO Box 551, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-2151,** for the use of the waters of **South Fork Sprague River, a tributary of Sprague River,** for the PURPOSE of **road watering**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 26, 1984**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.0 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **South 68 degrees East 905 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 13, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 16 East, WM, in the County of Lake.**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
