PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60190 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Fremont National Forest of PO Box 551, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-2151, for the use of the waters of South Fork Sprague River, a tributary of Sprague River, for the PURPOSE of road watering

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 26, 1984

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South 68 degrees East 905 feet from the Northwest Corner of Section 13, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 36 South, Range 16 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
