PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68363 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald J. and Sherry A. Murphy of HC 60, Box 58, Idleyld Park, Oregon 97447, phone 498-2435, for the use of the waters of the North Umpqua River, a tributary of the Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 1.0 acre and domestic use for two families including irrigation of lawns and gardens not to exceed one-half acre in area for each family, being 0.013 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for domestic use that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 28, 1985 for use of 0.02 cfs and July 10, 1985 for use of 0.003 cfs

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.023 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 100 feet South and 230 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 26 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 26 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each
Section 16 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 1, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1988
