PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68537** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **James Joseph Heuer, of 2185 Melton Road, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-7019,** for the use of the waters of Melton Creek, a tributary of South Deer Creek, for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 3, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **560 feet North and 730 feet West from the Southeast Corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 28 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 12 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 1, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1987**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1988**.
