PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

"CERTIFICATE NO. 57202"

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68381** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **James W. Taylor of 1135 Sleepy Hollow Loop, Grants Pass, Oregon 97527, phone 479-2617,** for the use of the waters of the Applegate Lake Reservoir, constructed under Application R-57600, Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of **supplemental irrigation of 6.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **June 10, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **12.0 acre-feet of stored water only**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **360 feet North and 2004 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 8	SW 1/4 NE 1/4	5.0 acres
	SE 1/4 NE 1/4	1.0 acre

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4.5 acre-feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from storage from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810, and is subject to the terms and conduit of Contract No. 5-07-10-W0556, or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file with the Water Resources Department, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 15, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
