## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68421 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Gene B. Gary and Evelyn R. Gary of South Myrtle Route, Box 206, Myrtle Creek, Oregon 97457, phone 863-3498, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of South Myrtle Creek,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 3.5 acres, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.04 cfs for irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

July 2, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.045 cfs

e POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 500 feet South and 720 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 29 The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 29 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 29 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.5 acres Domestic use for one family

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the use of water for irrigation during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year is limited to the irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 15, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
