PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68541 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

is permit is issued to Director of Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs, Oregon Veterans' Affairs Building, 700 Summer Street, NE, Salem, Oregon 97310, for the use of the waters of the Grande Ronde River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 148.89 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 6, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

3.72 cfs

300 feet South and 850 feet East from the Northwest The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Corner of the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Union.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 South, Range 39 East, WM Section 4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 35.6 acres Irrigation SE 1/4 SE 1/4 38.5 acres Irrigation Section 3 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 39.4 acres Irrigation Section 9 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 35.39 acres Irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 15, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
