PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 65053 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761, for the use of the waters of Sprague River,

road construc

for the PURPOSE of

road construction, maintenance and dust abatement

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

April 28, 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cfs provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per year

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1380 feet North and 1400 feet West, from the Southeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 7 East, WM Section 22 through 27 Section 35 and 36 Section 34	Road construction, ALL maintenance, and dust abatement ALL E 1/2
Township 35 South, Range 8 East, WM Section 19, 20, 29, 30 Section 31	ALL
and 32 Township 36 South, Range 7 East, WM Section 1, 2, 11, 12 Section 3	ALL
and 10 Township 36 South, Range 8 East, WM Section 6 and 7 Section 5	E 1/2 ALL
and 8	W 1/2

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 27, 1986and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
