PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65053** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 882-7761**, for the use of the waters of Sprague River, for the PURPOSE of **road construction, maintenance and dust abatement**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **April 28, 1983**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **1.0 cfs** provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed **3.0 acre-feet per year**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1380 feet North and 1400 feet West, from the Southeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Township 35 South, Range 7 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
