PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68563** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Marilyn M. Boe of 511 NW Woodson Drive, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 474-1267,** for the use of the waters of the Rogue River, a tributary of Pacific Ocean,
for the PURPOSE of **domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **September 24, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **410 feet South and 1400 feet East from the Center Corner of Section 26, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 35 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 35 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 26 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Provided that all construction work is subject to the provisions of the Scenic Water Ways Act.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 27, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
