## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **65403** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **U.S. Malheur National Forest of John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731**, for the use of the waters of unnamed tributaries of Silvies River at the **Range Spring, Chesmore Spring and Boulder Spring sites**, for the PURPOSE of **livestock, being 0.015 cubic foot per second from each source, provided the total quantity diverted from all sources shall not exceed 0.015 cfs**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **May 20, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.015 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **Ranger Spring - 2600 feet South and 1900 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 22, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 22; Chesmore Spring - 200 feet South and 2500 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28; Boulder Spring - 2600 feet South and 2200 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 16, being\***  
A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* **within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, all in Township 19 South, Range 31 East, WM, all in the County of Harney.**

	Section 28 NW 1/4 NE 1/4	Livestock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **November 27, 1985** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**
