PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 66364 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Prineville, Oregon 97754, phone 447-3825, for the use of the waters of Miller Spring, a tributary of Keeney Creek, for the PURPOSE of livestock

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 19 1983

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed

0.005 cfs

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 784 feet North and 1073 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 23, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 20 East, WM, in the County of Crook.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 17 South, Range 20 East, WM Section 23 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Livestock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 6, 1986**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with October 1, 19 87 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19
