PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68607** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Carl A. Gerlinger of 3791 Augusta National Drive, S., Salem, Oregon 97302, phone 585-2052,** for the use of the waters of **North Fork Ash Creek and four duck lakes, a tributary of Willamette River,** to be constructed under * **maintenance of the four duck lakes for duck attraction**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **November 1, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.3 cfs**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **2670 feet North and 400 feet West from the Southeast Corner of David Grant DLC 43, being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Township 8 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 3 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Duck Lakes
NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SE 1/4 NE 1/4**

The right allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future rights for beneficial consumptive uses.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **December 16, 1986** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1987**

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before **October 1, 1988**
