PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68594** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to

McMillin Brothers Construction, T.O. McMillin, President of PO Box 226, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, for the use of the waters of Grave Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of mining during the period November 1 to May 1 of each year

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

October 21, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **200 gallons per minute**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:

800 feet South and 25 feet West from the E 1/4 Corner of Section 29, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 33 South, Range 4 West, WM.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 29 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Placer Mining

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 31, 1987** and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1988**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19**89**.
