PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68581 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lester S. Roberts and Margaret R. Roberts of Box 281, Mosier, Oregon 97040, phone 478-3406, for the use of the waters of the an unnamed stream and Spring 2, tributaries of Mosier Creek,

for the PURPOSE of use in farm labor camp and supplemental irrigation of 16.4 acres, being 0.02 cfs for use in farm labor camp and 0.23 cfs for supplemental irrigation

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 27, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed stream - 100 feet North and 880 feet East; Spring 2 - 240 feet North and 720 feet East, both from the Center Corner of Section 12, both being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 2 North, Range 11 East, WM Section 12 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 16.1 acres
Supplemental irrigation
and Farm labor camp
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.3 acre
Supplemental irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/60 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
