PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68614 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Franklin W. Ayres of 13221 Mann Road, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97603, phone 882-5912, for the use of the waters of an unnamed pond, a tributary of Spring Lake,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 15.5 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 15, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 170.0 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 510 feet North and 990 feet West from the East 1/4 Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 9, Township 40 South, Range 9 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South, Range 9 East, WM Section 9 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 15.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 7, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1987.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
