November 20, 1985 for 0.01 cfs and December 12, 1985 that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from for 0.01 cfs

0.02 cubic and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed foot per second

566 feet North and 20 feet West from the Southeast The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Corner of Section 29, being being within the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 6 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the County of Lincoln.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 10 West, WM Section 29 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for three families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each

Section 32 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden each

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
