PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68558 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ronald H. Gourley of Kellogg Route, Box 105-M, Oakland, Oregon 97462, phone 459-1299, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of fish rearing

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from September 18, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 2370 feet North and 800 feet East from the Southwest Corner of Section 28, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 23 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 23 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 28 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Fish rearing

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19, 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
