PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68626** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Morrow County, Oregon** by the **Morrow County Court, 100 Court Street (PO Box 788), Heppner, Oregon 97836, phone 676-9061**, for the use of the **waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Willow Creek**, for the PURPOSE of **campground uses (restrooms, kitchens, trailer hook-ups, baths, showers, and tent-camp spigats)**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **December 9, 1985**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.02 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **1500 feet North and 580 feet East from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 27, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 4 South, Range 28 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South, Range 28 East, WM Section 27 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Campground uses

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **March 21, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**.
