## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68627 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jess L. Smith and Anita L. Smith, Little River Road, Glide, Oregon 97443, phone 496-0228, for the use of the waters of Little River, a tributary of North Umpqua River,

for the PURPOSE of domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden from each family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

December 9, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second cubic

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 650 feet South and 750 feet East from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 12, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 27 South, Range 2 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South, Range 2 West, WM Section 12 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for two families including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and non-commercial garden for each

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 21, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
