## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 64131 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Arie and Elso DeJong of Route 1, Box 202, Bonanza, Oregon 97623, phone 545-6648, for the use of the waters of two spring areas, tributaries of Lost River

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 18.3 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

September 7, 1982

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.23 cubic per second** 

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 2000 feet North and 450 feet West; Diversion 2 - 1900 feet North and 600 feet West both from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 17, both being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 17, Township 39 South, Range 11 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 39 South, Range 11 East, WM Section 16 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 11.1 acres

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.2 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1987 reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
