PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68352** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **Scottsburg Rural Fire District, of PO Box 625, Scottsburg, Oregon 97473, phone 587-4268, for the use of the waters of a small unnamed stream, a tributary of Umpqua River,**
for the PURPOSE of **fire station, restroom and sink**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 24, 1986**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **990 feet South and 720 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 7, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 22 South, Range 9 West, WM Section 8 Lot 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) Fire Station

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 17, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**.
