This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68389 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to O.K. Tobey Sr., 33003 SW T.V. Highway, Hillsboro, OR, 97123, phone 640-4911, for the use of the waters of Christensen Creek, a tributary of Campbell Creek,

for the PURPOSE of maintenance of Tobey Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68388, Permit R-10603, for fish,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from

June 13, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0125 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1600 feet South and 580 feet East from the North 1/4 corner of Section 33, being within the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, Section 33. Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 1 South, Range 3 West, WM, Section 33 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Fish

Provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88
