## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68458 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to J. C. Williams of PO Box 1447, Fort Stockton, Texas, 79735, for the use of the waters of a natural drainageway, a tributary of North Powder River,

for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 27.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 63.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 31, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.25 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Diversion 1 - 800 feet South and 1155 feet West from the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of Section 28, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28; Diversion 2 - 165 feet South and 130 feet West from the Northeast corner of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 28, both of Township 6 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Union.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 87.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 88.
