PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **68658** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to **William E. and Alma J. Spicer, of PO Box 1050, Eagle Point, Oregon, 97524, phone (619) 265-0361,** for the use of the waters of Rogue River and Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Application R-56223, Permit R-8124, a * for the PURPOSE of **irrigation of 28.0 acres**

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from **January 21, 1986**

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed **0.35 cubic foot per second**

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: **957 feet South and 1282 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 29, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson. Lost Creek Dam is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and W 1/2 SW 1/4 of Section 26, Township 33 South, Range 1 East, WM.**
* tributary of Pacific Ocean,

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 6-07-10-WD606 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **April 17, 1987**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **87**.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 **88**.
