PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68444 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife of 506 SW Mill Street, Portland Oregon, 97201, phone 229-5701, for the use of the waters of Eel Creek, a tributary of Ten Mile Creek, for the PURPOSE of maintenance of Eel Lake Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68443, Permit R-10606, for fish rearing,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 18, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 835 feet North and 75 feet East from the Southwest Corner of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 6, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 6, Township 23 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.
