PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68496 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William S. and Mary W. Hillman of PO Box 864, Canyonville, Oregon, 97417, phone 839-4671, for the use of the waters of seven springs, tributaries of Calapooya Creek, for the PURPOSE of stock water and domestic use for three families including irrigation of lawns or non-commercial gardens not to exceed one half acre in area per family, being 0.005 cfs from each of Springs #1, #2, #4, #5 and #6 for livestock water; * that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 22, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.0449 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: #1 - 160 feet North and 1265 feet West from the center of Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4; #2 - 745 feet South and 1160 feet West from the center of Section 18, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4; #3 - 150 feet South and 290 feet East from the center of Section 18, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4; #8 - 540 feet North and 2040 feet West from the center of Section 18, being**

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * 0.0033 cfs from each of Springs #4, #5 and #6 for domestic use for one family; 0.01 cfs from Spring #8; 0.01 cfs from Spring #2 when available with any deficiency in supply at Spring #2 to be made up by appropriation from Springs #1 and #3 for domestic use for one family.
- ** within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4; #4 - 560 feet North and 980 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4; #5 - 410 feet North and 600 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4; #6 - 830 feet North and 720 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner of Section 18, being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4; all in Township 25 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

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Township 25 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 18 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.5 acres Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden from Spring #2, to be supplemented by Springs #1 and #3

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Stock water from Springs #1 and #2

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one half acre lawn and noncommercial garden from Spring #8; Stock water from Springs #1 and #2

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Stock water

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 9, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 . Extended to October 1, 1989

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
