PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68543 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Jerrold R. and Lucy M. Cooley of PO Box 198, Azalea, Oregon, 97410, phone 837-3616, for the use of waters of an unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the stream to be made up by * for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 5.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 15, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Unnamed stream- 170 feet South 300 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 17; Spring- 170 feet North and 600 feet West from the Center 1/4 Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 17, both of Township 32 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* appropriation from a spring, a tributary of Starveout Creek,

Township 32 South, Range 4 West, WM Section 17 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 5.0 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/70 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to the irrigation of a noncommercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 9, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
