PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68653 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Irene M. Jefferson of 18730 Depot Street, Monmouth, Oregon, 97361, phone 838-4740, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Luckimute River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from January 16, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1775 feet North and 1320 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 34, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 34, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM Section 34 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
