PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68416 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management of 3040 Biddle Road, Medford, Oregon, 97504, phone 776-4174, for the use of the waters of Applegate Reservoir, constructed under Application R-57600, Permit R-7810, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation of 36.9 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from June 28, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 60.0 acre-feet annually

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 125 feet North and 500 feet East from the center quarter corner of Section 1, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM Section 1 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 25.0 acres
NE 1/4 SW 1/4 11.9 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 5-07-10 W0542 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
