PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68625 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Clarence E. Green of Route 1, Box 27, Baker, Oregon, 97814, phone 523-2006, for the use of the waters of Washington Gulch Creek, a tributary of Powder River, for the PURPOSE of maintaining Green Gulch Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68580, Permit R-10616, for fish culture

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from December 9, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 10.0 gallons per minute

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 22 feet North and 810 feet West from the Southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of Section 11, being within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM, in the County of Baker.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM Section 11 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Fish culture

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 30, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
