## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 63234 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Wayne J. Blaylock of Riverside, Oregon, 97917, phone 493-2461, for the use of the waters of two streams, being 0.06 cubic foot per second from Stream 1 and 0.56 cfs from Stream 2 when available with any deficiency in the \* for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 78.3 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from February 5, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.62 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: Stream 1- 303 feet North and 1776 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 29, being within SE 1/4 SW 1/4; Stream 2- 70 feet North and 1320 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 29, being within SW 1/4 SW 1/4 both in Section 20, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

\* available supply from the two streams to be made up by appropriation from South Fork Malheur River and Reservoir #3 enlargement and Reservoir #4 to be constructed under Application P-63233, Permit R-10617, tributaries of Malheur River,

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, from direct flow and storage from reservoirs to be enlarged under Permit R-10617 and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1986, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
