## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68685 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Edward W. Lickar of Route 4, Box 287, Astoria, Oregon, 97103, phone 458-6789, for the use of the waters of Columbia River (inter-channel),

for the PURPOSE of domestic for one family

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 12, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 350 feet North and 500 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 17, being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM, in the County of Clatsop.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:  
Township 8 North, Range 8 West, WM Section 17 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
