## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

68687 This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68687 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

Virgil Byxbe of 4302 East Santa Ana, Fresno, California, 93726, This permit is issued to phone (209) 222-7103, for the use of the waters of South Fork Coquille River, a tributary of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 12.03 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 19, 1986

0.15 cubic foot and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 850 feet North and 1750 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 8, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8, Township 30 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: Township 30 South, Range 12 West, WM Section 8 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.03 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 SE 1/4 2.0 8.0 acres acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 C Extended to October 1, 1990
