PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68707 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to William W. Madewell of 270 River Road, Myrtle Point, Oregon, 97458, phone 572-5369, for the use of the waters of South Fork Coquille River, a tributary of Coquille River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 76.0 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from April 17, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.95 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 450 feet North and 1300 feet West from the East quarter corner of Section 8, being within the Lot 7 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 8, Township 29 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to $\frac{1}{80}$ of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 3, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
