PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68424 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Rodney N. Gradin of 5340 SE Chase, Gresham, Oregon, 97030, phone 663-3292, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Doane Creek, and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-68423, Permit R-10620, for the PURPOSE of recreation and irrigation of 10.0 acres, being 0.01 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream for maintaining the reservoir for recreation and 0.13 cfs from the unnamed stream and reservoir for irrigation that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from July 5, 1985

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1070 feet North and 130 feet East from the Southwest corner of SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 33, Township 1 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 1 South, Range 4 East, WM Section 33 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 9.5 acres irrigation
and Recreation
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 0.5 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-10620, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1988.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1989.
