PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68683 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Malheur County Housing Authority of 308 East Second Street, Nyssa, Oregon, 97913, phone 372-5658, for the use of the waters of Snake River, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 34.2 acres

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 10, 1986 for 0.025 cubic foot per second
April 14, 1986 for 0.835 cubic foot per second

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.86 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 550 feet South and 30 feet East from the Northwest corner of Lot 1 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4), being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, Township 19 South, Range 47 East, WM, in the County of Malheur.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 19 South, Range 47 East, WM	Section 28 Lot 5 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4)	7.6 acres
	Section 29 SE 1/4 SE 1/4	18.6 acres
	Section 32 NE 1/4 NE 1/4	4.1 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 17, 1987, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89.
