## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION           68737           and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to           Diane Cowden of PO Box 816, Joseph, Oregon, phone 426-4657, for the use of the waters of Wallowa Lake, a tributary of Wallowa River,

for the PURPOSE of   Domestic for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from           May 30, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed   0.005 cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED:   773 feet North and 1411 feet East from the West quarter corner of Section 5, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, WM, in the County of Wallowa.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 3 South, Range 45 East, WM Section 5 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before   July 17, 1987           , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88 .

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
