PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 68726 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to John A. and Norma C. Hebert, Sr. of 770 NE Hill Street, Sheridan, Oregon, 97378, phone 843-3038, for the use of the waters of South Fork of Yamhill River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation of 64.3 acres,

that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from May 13, 1986

and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.8 Cubic foot per second

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 3500 feet South and 2000 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 12, being within the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 6 South, Range 7 West, WM Section 12 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.3 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4 20.3 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.9 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 12.2 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 21.7 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.4 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.5 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to 1/80 of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 28, 1987 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 88.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 89 .
